

Outline, orientation study:

1. Survey of orientation features of Boston
(pedestrian area between Dovée & Berkeley sts.),
as noted from foot, car, subway.
2. Ask simple directions on street, & record.
3. For a prepared set of more complex directions:
 - a. make introspective analysis of the process
of moving through.
 - b. move through an ground & note the clues.
 - c. ask a selected few to give such directions,
& then to describe process of mental con-
struction.
4. Have number of people draw sketch map
of this area.

I from:

1. City Hall to Old North Church.
2. Custom House Tower to Music Oval.
3. Charles River Dam Circle to South Station.
4. Park Square Bus Terminal to Haymarket Circle
5. Elevated Station Dover & Washington to State House

Ask a few people to describe these routes, by car & by public transportation. Then to describe as best they can the mental process they went through. Also to do the same for a very familiar route.
