of the coats of arms in the dormers. The  
shields seem stuck on and should be  
designed so that they seem a part  
of the idea.

Four Porch Windows

- Old Arms of Christchurch Abbey "Azure" in a  
Orb, or the sacred monogram (Chi-Rho) sable"
- ✓ Arms of St Andrew, Azure a saltire argent
- St Patrick, argent a saltire gules.
- St George for England, argent a cross gules.

In clerestory or dormer windows use arms of  
✓ 12 apostles + (St. Paul, St. Luke) + (St. Mark) making  
15 in all as there are 15 openings. The ~~twelve~~  
apostles are + Andrew + Peter + James (the minor) + John  
(the evangelist) + Philip + Thomas + Matthew + James (the greater)  
(James the son of Alphaeus) + Simon + Judas (the brother of James)
