Around the figure of Christ are the Seven white doves, symbolizing the seven Gifts of the Spirit as in the Jesse Tree at Chartres; nine stars of heavenly steadfastness which may also symbolize the fruit of the Spirit; the Alpha and Omega, and the grapevine border with twelve bunches of grapes symbolizing the twelve Apostles.
