The two-panel window in the west wall of the same room, is devoted to the Archangels, Gabriel and Raphael. - Gabriel, Angel of the Annunciation, and messenger of peace, bears the traditional lily symbol, while Raphael, the guardian angel protects the young Tobias who holds his usual symbol, the fish.

In the small medallion below Gabriel, the Blessed Virgin kneels in prayer at the Annunciation; with the descending Dove near at hand; while Tobias and the fish is again suggested below Raphael.
