General Information

This window is to go next to the window devoted to The Three Marys, but is to have two medallions. The subject is to be The Raising of Lazarus and The Miraculous Draught of Fishes. (With this, return the Three Marys sketch, so that they can compare them.)

These windows of the aisle are to be kept in a somewhat lighter key than the great axial windows.

Design for second east aisle window.

As planned, it is devoted to the Miraculous Draught of Fishes and the Raising of Lazarus. In the lower medallion, Our Lord stands by, while Peter and his friends draw the net full of fishes; and in the upper medallion, Lazarus comes forth from the tomb at Our Lord's bidding. The sisters, Martha and Mary, are represented at one side. ~~We~~

While the field of the second window is enriched in much the same manner, as the first, the color scheme is considerably cooler. An alternation of cool and warm palettes will introduce a pleasant variety through the series."

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
