Canon Tarbell says, "I would recommend that you consider using more of the warm red tones than of the blue tones."

As planned, the one for the east aisle is devoted to the Healing of the man at the Pool of Bethesda, and the First Miracle at the Marriage at Cana.

Related symbols through the borders are the Cross Potent, emblem of Our Saviour's power to heal; the Fountain, - the healing waters of Life; a symbol of Marriage, - interlaced rings with the Chi Rho, and the Grapevine, true union of Our Lord and the Church.

We have accented the rubies and will emphasize the warm red tones still further in the selection of the glass.
