General Information To have symbols of The Trinity. "Although the Trinity is included in the symbolism of the great north window...it can be represented to good purpose in the tower group in a somewhat different manner."

As planned, it is devoted to the Trinity. The Hand of God from the cloud in the cruciform halo is the central symbol, with the Lamb bearing the cruciform banner of victory at the left, and the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit at the right.

The fields and borders are enriched with growing foliated pattern.

We have kept the palette quite light, thinking that abundant illumination is probably needed. If this is not true, we can strengthen the color and texture.
