General Information Theme: Christ Blessing Little Children, with angels in side panels as in Trinity Episcopal Church, Bessemer, Alabama. To be in harmony with our other windows there, but possibly slightly lighter.

Donor "likes the idea of the larger figure and not too much detail."

We have completed our study of the design of the choir windows for Mrs. Cooley and are sending you the rough color sketches, herewith, designed in a manner similar to the windows she liked.

The central panel is devoted to Our Lord Blessing little Children, with attendant angels in the attitude of prayer at either side.

The colorful medallions are set in foliated fields, flowering in lilies of purity. These fields are kept light to provide abundant illumination for the choir.

Be sure to use the lovely ruby red and pure blues - like we did in the Chapel window there.
