General Information The window on the north elevation to have a scene of John the Baptist proclaiming the Advent of Jesus; and the second scene in that window would be the Nativity.

*Ordered*  
The window on the east elevation to have Jesus in the Temple as a young boy of twelve; and then the scene of St. John and Jesus' Baptism.

Windows should be kept brilliant, though colorful, to admit an abundance of illumination.

The vestibule window in the east elevation is devoted to the Christ Child in the Temple with the Doctors, and the Baptism of Our Lord by Saint John the Baptist.

Saint John holds the Shell of water, and the Dove of the Holy Spirit is represented above Our Lord with descending rays of golden light.

The companion window in the north elevation represents Saint John proclaiming the Advent of Jesus, and the Nativity.

Saint John standing before the Jordan with rustic crossed staff, bears the scroll inscribed, - "Prepare ye the way of the Lord." Above is the Shell of Baptism.

Saint Joseph, the ox and ass, are included in the Nativity, with the Star of Bethlehem above.

Important: The Canon writes: "...In connection with the Castetter window, east elevation, ...we suggest that some of the blue be eliminated and a warmer tone be used, such as a pinkish shade. I feel that it is just a trifle cool ... "Make the blue a lighter shade.

Important note: When we come to do panel, Make the leaves of the border fairly delicate so that the ruby will be fairly predominant.
